HOW TO ORDER PARTS

Parts lists contained in this book have been prepared to help you when ordering spare and/or replacement parts. Your order will be filled promptly and accurately when the following information is provided:

- 1. Model and serial number of the unit. (This specifically identifies the equipment you have and permits us to verify the part numbers in your order.)
- 2. The parts list page number and catalog number. Include catalog revision number, if applicable.
- 3. The **Item** number for each part. **Item** numbers on the parts list page correspond with the numbers shown on the illustration.
- 4. **Part Number** as it appears in the parts list. In most cases this will be a nine-digit number; for example: 200-147-000.
- 5. The **Description** for the part as it appears on the parts list page.

The part ordered may have a new part number, or the part may have been replaced by a newer design with a different part number. In these cases your acknowledgement, shipping papers and invoices will be written listing the current part number first; the old part number you referred to will follow the part description.

Our purpose in doing this is to tell you that the parts are fully interchangeable. This will avoid any unnecessary correspondence or delay in processing your order. We suggest that you add any new number to your parts lists for future use.

Safety, Installation, Operation & Maintenance

SAFETY


SAFETY is our first concern at **ATI Corporation**. Safety must also be first in the mind of the operator of the quick attach. Proper maintenance is necessary to complete the safety cycle.

Attachments used with this Quick Attach must be compatible with the mounting system.

When attaching an attachment to the loader quick attach mounting frame, engage tractor parking brake, and stop tractor engine before dismounting tractor. Push the handles over center to the latch position to insure that the attachment is securely attached to the mounting frame.

INSTALLATION

Refer to Figure 1. Quick-changing of a loader mounted attachment is made possible with the quick-attach system. The quick-attach mounting frame is installed on the loader and held in place by the factory-supplied loader pins. The frame remains on the loader and the loader pins are not removed when changing attachments. The attachment is joined by matching the saddle hook at the top of the attachment plate with the top bar of the quick attach frame. Wedge blocks on the quickattach help to guide the hook into position over the bar.



Safety, Installation, Operation & Maintenance



Mounting an attachment:

- A) Pull the latch pin handle out to the unlatched position. The latch pin handle must be all the way up to ensure that the latching pins are fully retracted.
- B) Tilt the quick attach forward with the loader tilt cylinders. Ease the top bar of the mounting frame into the saddle hooks of the attachment plate. BE CERTAIN both hooks are captured by the bar before proceeding.
- C) Roll the mounting frame back and raise the loader boom slightly so that the back of the attachment plate rests flat against the front of the quick attach frame. When the attachment hooks are properly seated on the top rod and against the front of the quick-attach frame, set the tractor parking brake, turn off the tractor engine, and dismount the tractor.
- D) Push the latch pin handle down to the vertical latched position, to engage the latching pins.

Removing an attachment:

- A) Roll the attachment back and lower the loader so that the attachment is approximately one inch above the ground.
- B) Set the tractor parking brake, turn off the tractor engine, and dismount the tractor.
- C) Pull the latch pin handle up to the unlatched (horizontal) position to release the latching pins.
- D) Start tractor engine, tilt the attachment forward and slowly back away from the attachment at the same time.

MAINTENANCE


Attachments are secured to the quick attach with a spring-loaded, over-center latching pin system. It is important that these parts are kept clean and free of debris. If operation becomes difficult or sticky, lubricate the latching pins and the latching mechanism with a dry lubricant. Clean the bar at the top of the attachment plate and the latching pin holes of any dirt and debris before mounting an attachment to the quick attach.
